News from AStA and Stupa

Update on the semester ticket

Following the termination, there is now a solution for a nationwide semester ticket. This ticket works as a solidarity model. This means that the ticket is paid for by all students, regardless of individual use.

The contracts are currently being reviewed by the AStA. Unfortunately, the bicycle and passenger transport are no longer included. However, this is to be renegotiated in the next winter semester.

Mensa food and student residences will become more expensive

Due to rising costs, the Studierendenwerk Dortmund is dependent on subsidies from the state of NRW. The plans of the NRW state government do not currently provide for such subsidies. Due to a lack of options, the Studierendenwerk Dortmund therefore has to increase the prices of its canteens and halls of residence. This places an even greater financial burden on many students. From our point of view, action by the state government is absolutely necessary. For this reason, the student mobilization working group (AK StudiMob) will meet in the second calendar week to discuss further steps for action.
